- Financial Report
 - \$8,993 LEFT OVER FROM 2025

Regular Business:

Rule Clarifications/ Reminders

- Out fielders cannot throw a ball directly to 1st base to get the out on the batter running to 1.

- Rounding Bases
 - Runner must touch the base as they round, cannot cut the base when running
 - Runner must touch the orange bag when running to 1st
- Spray painting the “respect” (150 foot) line as out fielders cannot come in past that line before the ball is hit
- If only fielding 9 players in fall ball, the 10th batter is an auto out unless it’s the 3rd out, then it skips. Spring ball there will only be 9 batters.
- If there is a tie in the standings based on the teams win/loss records, the team with the better head-to-head record is placed higher. If the tied teams didn’t play each other (or head-to-head doesn’t break the tie), then the TRUE plus/minus will be considered for determining the higher seeded team.
