

2014 Fall Ball Rule Additions/Alterations from Spring League

- 1. You must actually touch all of the bases when running past them, or stop on the base when not advancing (not overrun and turn right, like spring league), with the exception of home plate. The no-touch home plate "line" is in effect.
- 2. Tagging in permitted. You must tag a runner on a non-force play for an out.
- 3. Sliding is permitted.
- 4. Women may bunt.
- 5. Three outs or 10 batters. On the tenth batter the ball MUST go home. A third out may not be made at first/second/etc.
- 6. Batting order continues each inning, following the person who was $3^{\rm rd}$ out.
- 7. Games will start at 6:00PM (starting September 1st). Teams may start earlier to make sure they get the full game in provided both teams agree on starting earlier.
- 8. Games are 7 innings long. In the event that a game must be called due to lack of daylight, the last full inning will be used. If light is getting low, both teams must agree to start the next inning.

All other rules from Spring League, including home team (first on schedule) and homerun rule (2-up).
